History

Facilities

Equine Facilities available for your use:

- 100' x 220' Outdoor Arena with Grass Footing that joins the covered pavilion
- 70' x 120' – "Performance" Arena
- 70' x 120' lighted, Covered Pavilion that would be available for you use during the day & after dark. (Ground work and light riding only – footing requires light work only)
- 45' & 60' Stationary round pens
- Multi use obstacle course
- 75 Miles of mountains trails for pleasure and cross training
- Ample parking and restroom facilities
- On-site restaurant

Cost - \$250 for facility use (Friday PM – Saturday PM) \$100 for each additional day

Camping

We have a beautiful campground located on Elk Creek that has 26 power & H2O hookups. These will be occupied on a first come first serve basis. No horses will be allowed to spend the night in the campground. Showers and restroom facilities are available. Fires must be contained in fire pits. There are shower & bathroom facilities located in each barn. All dogs must be kept on a leash. This is a resort rule.

Cost - \$30 per night

Stalls

All of our guests love the facilities! The barns are beautiful, with 65+ - 12'x12' & 12'x10' stalls, wash pits, bathrooms and a community tack room. We have sand paddocks for turn out use that you can use while your horses are here.

Some of the rental homes here have horse pastures where horses can be kept.

Cost - \$30 per night

The roads into Leatherwood are good roads that big rigs travel year round. The last 20 miles are curvy country roads that you just have to take your time on. There is very little elevation change when coming from most locations.
